

## How to Make a Wedding Centerpiece with Flowers

Tis' the season for wedding centerpieces, here's an easy Byte-Syze Learning tutorial to get you started!



### Step 1: Gather Your Supplies

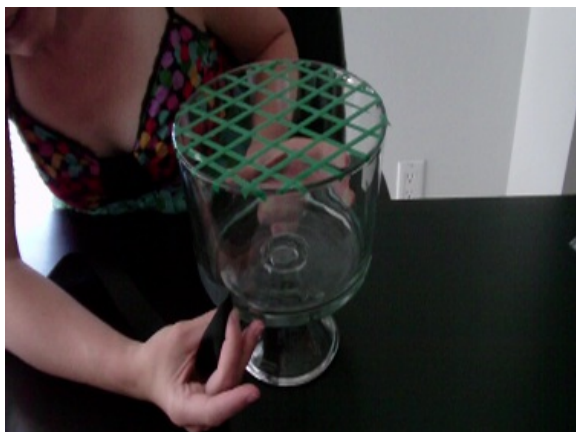
Make sure you have the following supplies before you get started:

- Scissors
- Waterproof Tape
- Ribbon
- Glue Dots
- Vase
- Flowers (not in photograph)



### Step 2: Create latticework with your waterproof tape

Create a patchwork effect with your waterproof tape over the opening in your vase. This will create slots for you to slip the stems of your flowers into in order to make them stand upright.



### Step 3: Begin wrapping the ribbon around the vase

Place glue dots around the vase and stick your ribbon to the glue dots, keeping the ribbon taut as you are wrapping the ribbon around the vase. I recommend starting at the bottom of the vase and working your way up to the top.



#### **Step 4: Repeat previous step to cover the vase**

Continue repeating the previous step until you've wrapped the entire area you would like to cover.



#### **Step 5: Assemble your Flower Arrangement**

In this step, you can assemble any flowers you would like to include in your centerpiece. We are blessed to live nearby the world famous Pike Place Market, so we took the centerpieces we had prepared up to a florist in the market and he was kind enough to add flowers for us (for only \$15 per vase)! What a pro!



#### **Step 6: The Finished Product**

Once your flowers have been arranged, you're finished. All you need to do is make sure there is water in the bottom of the vase and deliver them to your venue!
